

ABSTRACT

Background problem Local government system in Indonesia, is a subsystem of the system of government of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia which implements the principle of State law (*rechtsstaat*). In the implementation of the legislative function of DPRD and Local Government in making regional regulation for the implementation of regional autonomy is equal and no higher. However, in the local regulation, there are still constraints between the regional government and the local parliament, so that the objectives of regional autonomy can not be achieved in realizing the welfare of the community.

Problems: 1) Why the Buol District Rule on Regional Revenue can not be accomplished in realizing the objectives of regional autonomy, 2) What are the constraints encountered in the formulation of Regional Regulation between the Head of Region and the Regional House of Representatives (DPRD) in Buol District, 3) Has the relationship between the Regional Head and the Regional Representative Council (DPRD) of Buol Regency have occurred check and balance in the formation of the Regional Regulation.

Research Method: Based on the problems studied then the type of research is the normative legal research method. Normative law research method is done by examining the existing library materials. The research is also descriptive. In the normative legal research method, there are 3 kinds of library materials used by the author namely: primary legal materials, secondary legal materials and tertiary legal materials

Research Results: 1) Local regulations related to regional income of Buol Regency have not been able to realize the objectives of regional autonomy as a result of targeting regional income without paying due attention to the Buol community. The troubled regulation was finally lifted by the Minister of Home Affairs. 2) Obstacles and Obstacles encountered in the formation of a Regional Regulation are lack of checks and balances between the Regional Head and the Regional People's Legislative Assembly (DPRD), thereby inhibiting the formation of Regional Regulations in Buol District. 3) Check and Balance of the relationship of the Regional Head and the Regional Representative Council (DPRD) of Buol Regency in the formation of a Regional Regulation is a working relationship of equal standing and a partnership. but there are many contradictions between heads of regions and DPRDs in making decisions regarding the development of Buol Regency
