

ABSTRACT

Problems in this dissertation; 1. How is the role and function of the Police as one of the bearers of the internal security function? 2. What is the role and function across ministries in assisting the Police to maintain the internal security system? And 3. What is the national policy model for maintaining the internal security system in order to prevent deterrence and early detection of disruption of National Education? This research methodology is a normative and empirical legal research by examining the legal norms applicable to a particular situation, so that this research can be categorized as empirical law research. The result of the research can be concluded that: The role and function of the Police as one of the bearers of the function of internal security based on Law No. 2 of 2002 concerning the Police of the Republic of Indonesia is to maintain the security and public order, to uphold the law, and to provide protection, protection and service to the public for the maintenance of domestic security. While the function of the Police as an operational institution that bridges and accommodates various social, political, economic, and crime problems from various ethnic groups living within the territory of the Republic of Indonesia in the context of the management of internal security. Thus the role and function of the Police is a task carried from the government whose implementation is done by the Police of the Republic of Indonesia. Cross-Ministry's Role and Function in Assisting the Police to Maintain the Domestic Security System, that the Ministry is an institution that carries out government policies across sectors. In the internal security system, implemented through institutional coordination between ministries periodically and directed as written in the policy of each Ministry. The National Policy Model for Maintaining the Domestic Security System in the Framework of Preventing Deterrence and Early Detection of Kamtibmas Disorder is established through the synergy and integrity between security actors, namely Polri, Regional Government, TNI and BIN. The development and stabilization of territorial guidance models that harass local governments as internal security stakeholders, with the help of Polri and TNI integrated with BIN, other ministries and communities can anticipate the prevention of deterrence and early detection of domestic security disturbances, provided the *regai urrioreila*.
