Furthermore, the central government provides village funds in accordance with the Regulation of the Minister of Villages, Development of Disadvantaged Regions, and Transmigration of the Republic of Indonesia Number 19 of 2017 concerning Priority Setting for the Use of Village Funds for 2018.

Why did the Village Fund Corruption Crime occur in the city of Prabumulih based on Law number 6 of 2014 concerning Villages. 2) What are the legal sanctions for criminal acts of corruption in village funds in the city of Prabumulih 3). What are the efforts made to prevent criminal acts of corruption in village funds in the city of Prabumulih. The methodology used is normative legal research where normative research is carried out by examining existing library materials, the research is also carried out in a descriptive manner. In legal research, there are 3 (three) types of library materials used by the authors, namely primary legal materials, secondary legal materials and tertiary legal materials.

Research results 1. There was a criminal act on village funds due to the low level of human resources, both formal and non-formal, and there was no communication with the apparatus above them. 2. Legal sanctions for criminal acts of village funds are regulated in Article 26 of Law Number 6 of 2014 concerning Villages that (1) The village head is in charge of administering village administration, Article 29 letter a stipulates that village heads are prohibited from harming the public interest. Village heads who do not carry out their obligations receive sanctions as formulated in Article 30 of Law Number 6 of 2014 concerning Villages 3. Efforts are made to give the rights and obligations of village communities by providing guidance and supervision, as formulated in Article 68 of Law Number 6 2014 concerning Villages. Suggestions: 1. Each candidate for village head must be a person with a formal Bachelor of Laws education. 2. To provide guidance and supervision on the performance of the village head.
