ABSTRACT

Putra Sang Fajar El Harry/NIM: 19730292, Title MODEL OF IMPLEMENTING THE HEALTH INSURANCE SYSTEM BY THE SOCIAL SECURITY ORGANIZING AGENCY (BPJS) HEALTH FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES, under guidance of Prof. Dr. Zudan Arif Fakrulloh, S.H., M.H. as a Promoter and Prof. Dr. St. Laksanto Utomo, S.H., M.Hum. as Co. Promoter.

Based on Law No. 24 of 2011 about BPJS which is followed up to Law no. 40 of 2004 concerning about SJSN. It tells that, health services are under one of managements by BPJS Kesehatan. However, it is not all health services for army members can be fulfilled by BPJS Kesehatan. As being follow-up, the government issued Presidential Regulation No. 107 of 2013 concerning Certain Health Services, related to the operational activities of the Ministry of Defense, the Indonesian National Armed Forces and the Indonesian National Police.

Hence, it points out a problem formulation: 1. How is the condition of the health service toward army members before joining the health insurance? 2. How is the condition of the health service toward army members after joining the insurance? 3. How is the ideal model of helath service system toward army members? Based on the problems raised, this type of research method. The theoretical framework includes: Theory of the rule of law, Theory of Legal Protection, Theory of Justice, Theory of State Responsibility and Theory of Legal Harmonization.

Research Results: health services or YanKes, aimed in achieving optimal health for soldiers who needs a helath treatment at soldiers hospitals in accordance witg applicable procedures and regulations. The Health Support or DukKes also aimed directly in supporting training, operasional tasks, the health check, health services resulting form soldier training and operational activities, helath checks for prospectivesoldiers or werving and other field activities including health assistance. It concludes health services due to illness which is not supported by BPJS Kesehatan. Thece, there needs to be discretion or the existence of a lex specialist in providing health services for soldiers, but without violating the rules and in accordance with the characteristics soldiers health services which are commad-based and centralized system.
