ABSTRACT

Taufiq, Medical Dispute Resolution at MKDKI From The Perspective Of Justice for Doctor and Patients, under the guidance of Prof.Dr. Faisal Santiago, SH,MM as promoter and Prof.Dr. St. Laksanto Utomo, SH,MHum, as Ko. Promoter.

MKDKI is a professional judiciary institution for doctors and dentists which is given a special mandate by law. In other words, all disciplinary violations of doctors and dentists are resolved first by the MKDKI as a special court, not a general court, in accordance with Article 67 of Law no. 29 of 2004 concerning Medical Practice. In other words, all cases of disciplinary violations of doctors and dentists are resolved by the MKDKI, not by the general judiciary, unless in the MKDKI examination and decision, an element of deliberate evil acts by professional doctors and dentists is found. In reality, there are inconsistencies in the role and position of MKDKI in existing jurisprudence.

The problem is: what are the legal regulations for resolving medical disputes in MKDKI, how is justice achieved by doctors and patients in resolving medical disputes in MKDKI and what are the ideal legal rules regarding resolving medical disputes in MKDKI? The research method used is normative legal research using a

sociological approach. law.

The results of the research were that the Indonesian Medical Discipline Honorary Council (MKDKI) was formed based on the mandate of Article 55 paragraph (1) of Law Number 29 of 2004 which states: To uphold the discipline of doctors and dentists in carrying out medical practice and dentists in carrying out medical practice, a Council was formed. Honorary Discipline of Indonesian Medicine. The implementation of justice obtained by doctors and patients in resolving medical disputes at MKDKI is still weak because in its implementation, the role and position of MKDKI are interpreted and applied differently in various jurisprudence. The ideal legal rules regarding resolving medical disputes at MKDKI are the existence of legal rules that regulate MKDKI's authority as an institution implementing medical discipline. The Indonesian Medical Discipline Honorary Council (MKDKI) is an institution that has an important role in implementing medical discipline. This institution is not a mediation institution in the context of medical dispute resolution mediation, but as a state institution that has the authority to determine whether or not there have been errors committed by doctors/dentists in the application of medical/dental disciplines and to apply sanctions for doctors/dentists who are found guilty.
